## 1. Spooky Nostalgia

•Objective: Capture four images that create a creepy, old-school vibe without being overly scary. Think of classic Halloween with shadows, old buildings, foggy mornings, or eerie objects.

•Instructions: Try different angles and lighting to make each image feel like part of an old horror movie. Aim for variety—maybe one close-up, one silhouette, and one wide shot for atmosphere.

•**Deliverable:** Upload four photos to redwood.photography with a one-sentence caption for each, explaining what makes it spooky.

For capturing "Spooky Nostalgia," try photographing at the **CSF Trunk or Treat event** or on **Halloween night**. Both offer perfect chances to capture eerie lighting, creative costumes, and that classic Halloween atmosphere. Look for scenes with fog, glowing jack-o'-lanterns, or groups of people in shadowy settings to really nail the spooky vibe.

## 2. Hands with Purpose

•**Objective:** Tell a story using hands in four photos. Capture hands doing something meaningful, like holding a friend's hand, sketching, or building something. Show how hands can say a lot without words.

•Instructions: Take four different shots where the hands are the focus, each telling a unique story. Play with light and positioning to show a different feeling in each photo.

•Deliverable: Upload four photos with captions that describe the story or feeling behind each shot.
